**147** different people have contacted C.L.E.A.R. for information or assistance.



**46** people with substance use disorder (SUD) have been connected to a Peer Recovery Coach.



**24** people with SUD maintain contact with a Recovery Coach.



**28** concerned family members or friends have been connected to a Family Recovery Coach.

**18** Family members maintain contact with a Recovery Coach.



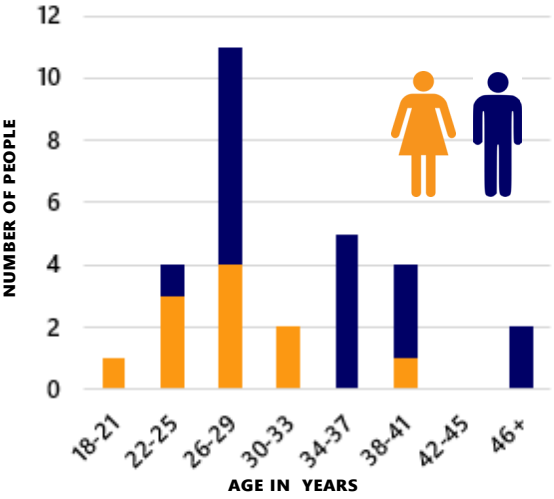
**35** people with SUD have been assisted to Access Treatment.
